



High mountains , ancient villages



Recommended time for this tour:

The best time is in summer with a staying of 5 days so that you can see the most important attractions.

Kufstein

A beautiful town on the coast of Inn offers many attractions and many exhibits and events during the whole year. For example the castle Kufstein – this is a fortress on about 26.000 m² - much bigger than the town itself – opening hours for the visitors are:

In summer: from 3rd April to 2nd November, every day from 9 to 17 o'clock

In winter: from 3rd November, from 10 to 16 o'clock

You will end this stay in Kufstein with a typical Tyrolese evening.

Hall in Tirol

With medieval buildings, roman gardens and small streets offers the historical centre a magnificent and romantic stay. The city doesn't offer only this but also the culture, sports and beautiful shops, which wake your desire to shop. During the summer time there are many traditional concerts at the Open-Air Festivals.

Imst

A town of sun and fountains (there are more than 18 of them) with very hospitable and friendly inhabitants.

In this land you can meet with culture and tradition step by step:

Different traditional museums (there is one of the oldest Schnapsmuseum), there is also a possibility to make a walk between the river and mountains.

Mittersill

While you climb on the highest mountain of Austria, with the glacier Großglockner you arrive in the region of Salzburg – the first town that you see is Mittersill.

Finally, you will be brought in the tourist zone of the national park Hohe Tauern. The last part of the eastern Alps, where the cultural Landscape melts with the natural landscape, there where the time doesn't flows, but it goes by

in the rhythm, which you decide. The nature shows its magical Multiplicity: walking you can see the windmills, workshops and historical Votive chapels.

You can also make a break on a meadow,

When it was a good summer, the cows come down to the meadows that are decorated with flowers and fir trees.

At the restaurant you can smell the perfume of the traditional specialities, like for example Kasnocken and you can also feel the harmony with the nature.
