



Cruise on the Danube



1st DAY

Budapest

Embarkment in the Budapest at late afternoon. Placement in the cabins, presentation of the crew. After that comes the welcoming-appetizer. Dinner on board. Free evening for an individual walk through the illuminated Budapest or folkloristic spectacle in Budapest.

2nd DAY

Budapest-Bratislava

Breakfast on board. When you want, you can make a tour by bus through Budapest. A town with many interesting historical facilities that are situated on both sides of the river.

Return to board by lunch.

Begin of the navigation at about 13 hours in the direction of Bratislava.

Dinner on board and evening with animations.

3rd DAY

Bratislava-Vienna

Breakfast on board.

At about 8.30 you can make a guided tour through Bratislava. Dominated by peaks of Small Carpathes in north, bathed by Danube, owns Bratislava a unique position. The charm of the capital of Slovakia reflects from the historical part of the town, with beautiful baroque castles and numerous churches.

Return to the ship for lunch and navigation in the direction of Vienna.

Arrival in Vienna at about 20 hours. Dinner and possibility to visit Vienna or to have a evening off

4th DAY

Vienna

Breakfast on board. Free time in the morning or visit of the castle Schönbrunn and one part of the city.

Vienna, imperial city and cradle of music, which becomes lively round about the Cathedral and State Opera.

The castle Schönbrunn, with wonderful garden, was earlier the summer residence of imperial family of Franz Josef and Sissy.

Return to board for lunch. Free afternoon in Vienna or visit of the exposition 2006 at the Albertina museum, which is

dedicated to the 250th birthday of the famous composer.

You can enjoy in the magnificent atmosphere when Mozart was on the highest point of his carrier, time between the descent of Rococo and the birth of Renaissance.

From 14th August you can also discover Mozart during a visit to the House of Music.

Dinner on board. In the evening you can visit the Viennese Concert, depends on the availability of places.

Departure of the ship on late night.

5 th DAY

Melk-Passau

Breakfast on board. Trip to the most beautiful part of the region Wachau. Arrival in Melk at about 9 o'clock. There is also an elective excursion by bus to Dürnstein.

Colourful village, the most known in the region Wachau for the legend about the king Richard the Lionheart and where you can find one very colourful church in the baroque style.

Return on board for lunch.

Elective visit of the monastery in Melk. This cathedral, in baroque style, is situated on the top of a rock that dominates over Danube with a height over 50 meters.

Return on board, departure to Passau at about 16 hours. Dinner and gala evening on board.

6 th DAY

Passau

Breakfast on board. Debarkation and the end of our services. For reasons of safety of the navigation there might be some changes of the program that will be made by Captain or Company.
