#### 1st DAY

Arrival of the group in Krakau

Meeting with Italian-speaking tour guide, which will escort the group the whole time during the stay in Poland Dinner and overnight-stay at the hotel in Krakau. AY

## 2<sup>nd</sup> DAY

### Krakau-Kalwaria Zebrzydowska-Wadowice-Czestochowa-Krakau

Breakfast at the hotel

In the morning, departure to the Kalwaria Zebrzydowska – one of the most important pilgrim centres in Poland after Czestochowa. The entire hill has been reconstructed into stairs, but it still responds the morphology from Jerusalem. After that, departure to Wadowice – the birthplace of John Paul II and visit of Pope's house and of the Christen fountain. In the afternoon we continue with Czestochowa and we will visit the monastery of Madonna Nera in Jasna Gora, with Italian-speaking tour guide.

Return to Karakau

Dinner and overnight-stay at the hotel.

## 3rd DAY

## Krakau-Lagiewniki-Wieliczka-Krakau

Breakfast at the hotel

In the morning tour through the Krakau with local tour guide, which speaks Italian (the old town, Hill of Wawel with the cathedral, the Market Square, the church of Virgin Maria)

Next place is the Lagiewniki – famous monastery of the heavenly mercy, which was officially recognized by Pope John Paul II in the year 2002 (opportunity to see the holy mass at the basilica)

In the afternoon - Visit of the Wieliczka

Dinner at the restaurant typical for the old town and overnight-stay at the hotel
