



## Graz e Styria



### 1st DAY

Arrival in Graz in the afternoon. Dinner and overnight-stay at the hotel.

### 2<sup>nd</sup> DAY

Morning will be dedicated to the guided tour through the city, also named "Green city" because of its special position. Visit of the powerful Clock Tower, which was built in the year 1569 and which is the symbol of town, then the town hall, old weapons stockpile, Domkirche and the castle, which dominates the city at most: powerful fortress from only remained two towers and bastion, which were built in year 1544.

Lunch in the restaurant.

Dinner and overnight-stay at the hotel.

### 3rd DAY

The first inter-station during the excursion in this beautiful region is the church in Bärnbach coloured by Hunderwasser. This is an obligation for every visitor.

The rest of the day will be dedicated to the discovery of wine route – from Graz you will pass all villages in the region, which are important for the wine production. Rareness on the Schillerstraße is the one sort of Rosé wine, which is only produced in this region. This is one of the most beautiful regions in Austria and the inhabitants are very friendly.

In this region is also one sort of pumpkin seed oil produced, one of a kind in the world.

After that you will go to Piber, where you can see the riding stable of Lippizaner horses, their summer riding stable. Visit of the stables between April and September.

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Lunchbreak.

In the afternoon you will go to Tavern " Buschenschank" where you can drink house made wine and where you can eat typical bread specialities.

Return to the hotel, light dinner and overnight-stay.
